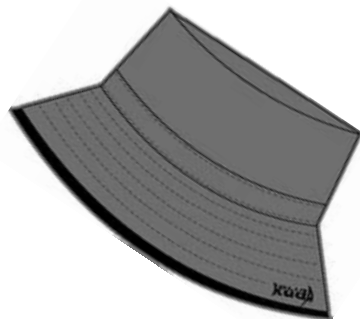
How many legs

be watching ants and ladybugs in their own habitats. What bugs do you see outside?



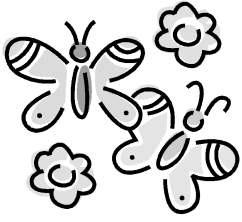
Bucket Hat Sales



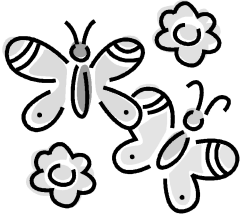
Thank you to all the families that purchased a bucket hat for their child. The Auction Committee will be using the proceeds to purchase fun things for the playground.

We would also like to thank all the dads that have brought us sand. We (the teachers) appreciate the delivery service and they (the children) love a full sandbox.

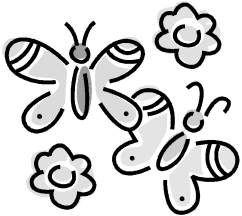
Welcome Claire's School of Dance



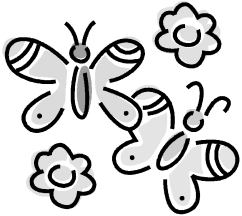
We are pleased to announce Claire's School of Dance will be our newest extra curricular activity.



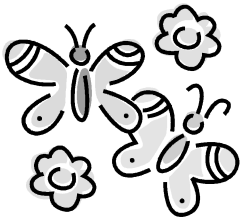
Dance classes will begin on Tuesday Sept. 12th with registration forms available soon (we will post it on the big board).
