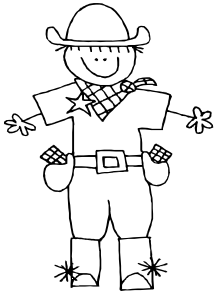
Did you get a new cell phone? Have you changed offices? Maybe you have moved recently.

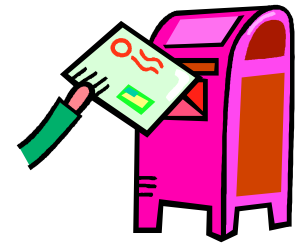


Go Texan Day

This year we will have a special preview event to highlight our upcoming auction on April 21st. Please stop by our auction booth to pick up information.

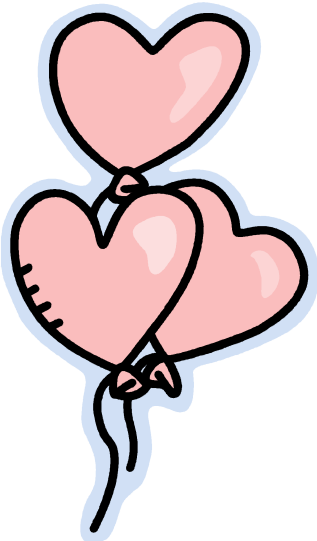
******* In the event of rain, children will pass through Treebeard's and volunteers will pass out the beads.

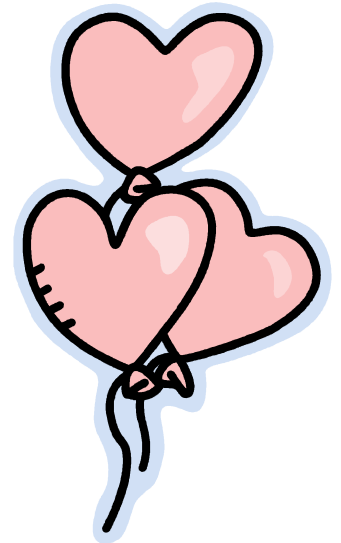
