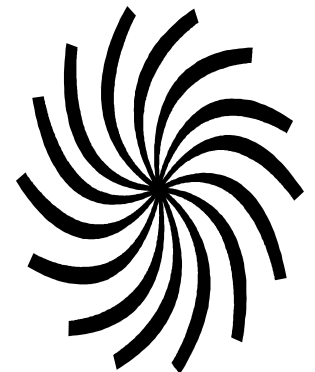
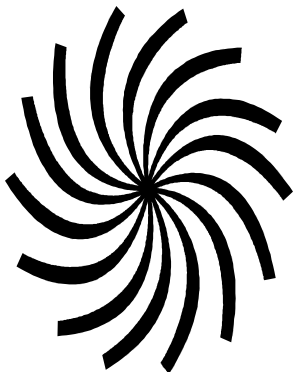

If your child will be out of school that day, please let the front desk know.

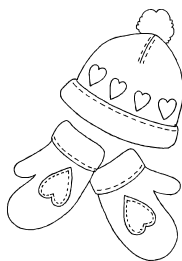
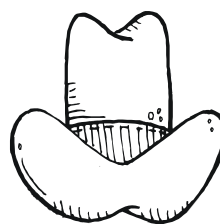


Silly Hat Day

Please re-enroll for the Spring Semester

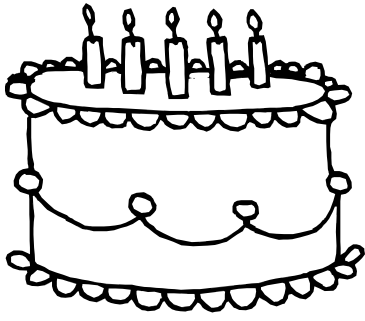
It is time to enroll for dance. Arts Alive Dance runs on semesters. The registration forms for the Spring semester are

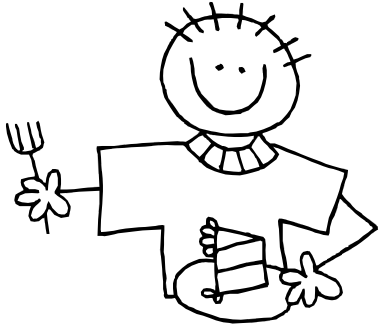

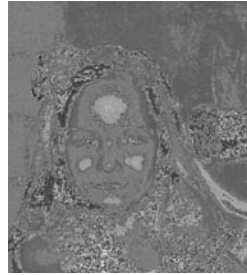

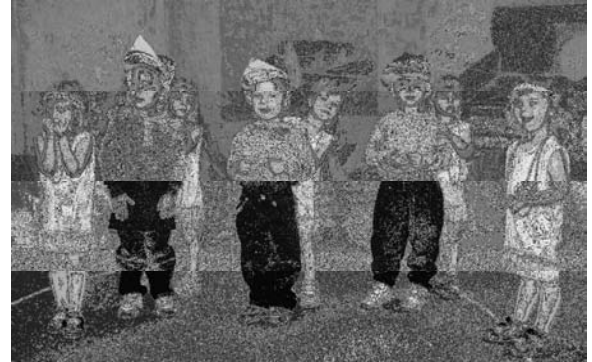
