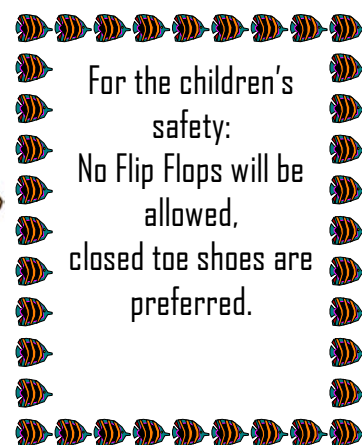

closed toe shoes are preferred.

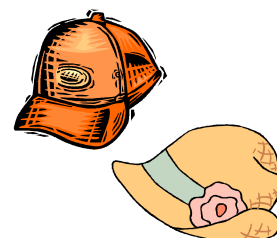
Let’s Keep Protected from the Sun!!!!

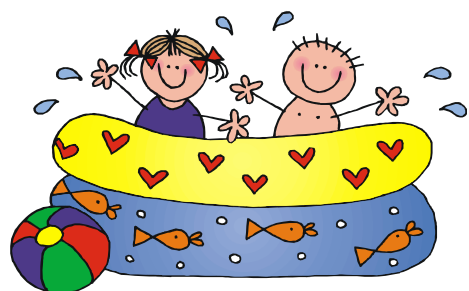
wearing a hat while playing outside can keep our skin protected.

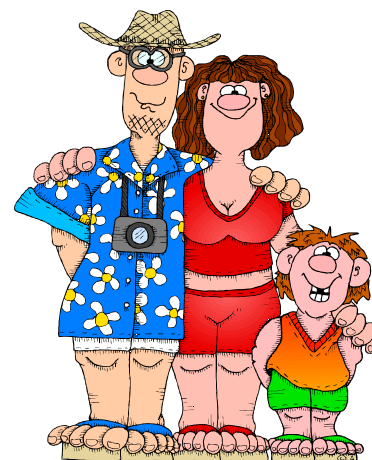
Please send your child to school dressed in their swimsuits and cover-up.

vacation or even just a long weekend.

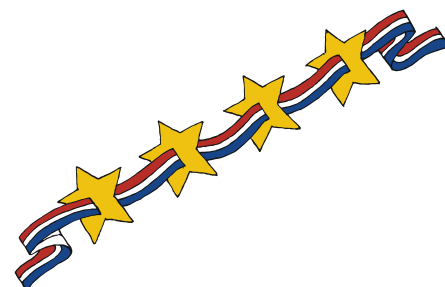
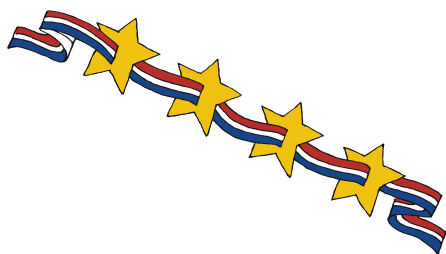
Plus, we really do miss the children when they are out and like to know they are having fun!

Parking is on your own. Please leave the spaces in front of the school open for those not staying. We will be happy to take your child to class while you park elsewhere.

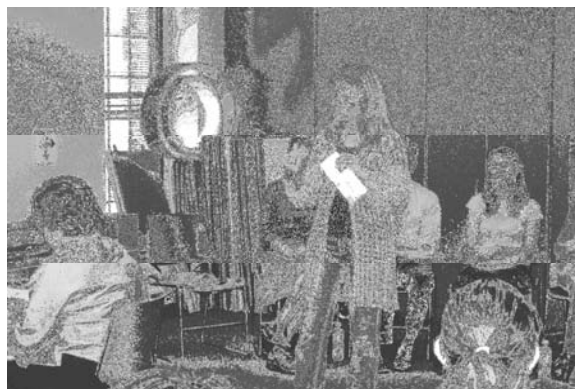

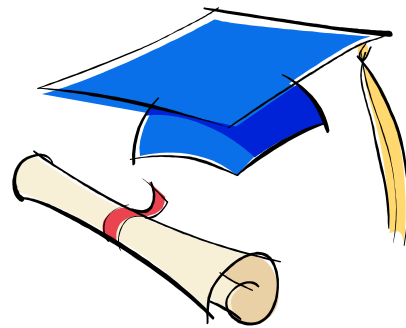
Movement II joins Toddler I for a picnic outside. We LOVE this beautiful weather.
