## It's Time To Plan For Your Child's Summer/Fall

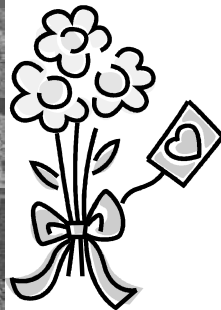
We are beginning to look forward to the Summer months. To assist in our planning, please let the front desk know:

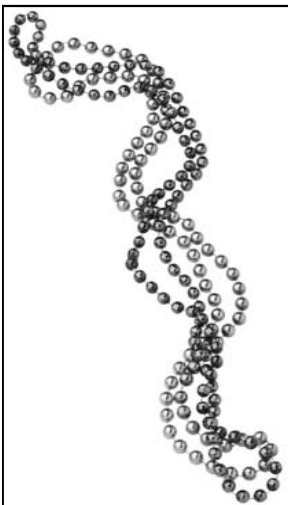
We can hardly wait for the excitement! Here are a few hints to make the season a little easier on us all:
